

The golf course is looking to get a lady's golf night organized. This would be a very informal get together, from beginner up.



A BIT ABOUT YOUR MUSEUM:

Thirty-nine rooms, areas and buildings house over 4200 artifacts that have been catalogued, accessioned and computerized.

In 2019 seventeen members were elected to the Board of Directors which included a Town Representative and a Legion Representative.

It has been brought to the attention of the Board of Directors that several Directors will not seek re-election in the New Year. Their decision is strictly age related and has nothing to do with our love and dedication to your Museum.

The Museum is owned by the Town of Birch Hills and is operated by a dedicated group of volunteers which includes a thriving Thrift Shop and coffee room.

We are open year round. The Thrift Shop opens on Wednesdays from 9:00am to 4:00pm and Saturdays from 1:00pm to 4:00pm. Coffee is on at 2:00pm both days. The Museum is open every Wednesday from 2:00pm to 4:00pm, and by appointment.

We need help folks if we are to carry on. Regular meetings are held the first Wednesday of each month.

Our Museum has been described as "Birch Hills' Best Kept Secret".

If you haven't seen it, now is the time.

The Birch Hills Golf Course was founded in 1926...our golf course is a beautiful hidden gem - a 9 hole, grass green golf course. Unfortunately, our clubhouse is almost as old as the golf course, but unlike the course, it hasn't improved with age.

The clubhouse is at its end of life – the building shifts every year and we are always amazed that the floor hasn't fallen in or the attached screen room hasn't separated; our deck is in need of replacing; our freezers and some of our coolers are located in the public areas, and the kitchen needs renovations to adhere to Public Health regulations...we could go on, but you get the idea.

We have designed a new clubhouse which will allow for a more functional kitchen, seating and retail space, increased storage and bathrooms that meet Public Health regulations. The Clubhouse and Golf Boards are excited about the new plans and eager to start construction. We have already raised approximately \$150,000 and have purchased some fixtures for the new clubhouse.

The Golf Board is requesting patrons, suppliers, community members and interested parties to consider making a tax deductible donation to our building fund. Donations may be made by:

Donations over \$20.00 will receive an official tax receipt; cheques must be made out to The Town of Birch Hills with the memo field stating "Golf Clubhouse Fund".

A charitable donation is a great way to help community initiatives and to receive a credit on your income taxes...as an example, in 2018, a \$400 donation could equate to \$140 tax savings. Of course, this is based on your tax bracket, so savings could be even more.
