

- To qualify you need to own the land and your entire crop seeded must be insured, unless an Application for Exemption of Crops form is submitted prior to April 30<sup>th</sup> each year.

- Coverage options include, full, straight and disappearing deductibles.

- Once enrolled your coverage is continuous, crop reports due by June 15 each year.

- Up to \$500/acre coverage (conditions apply).
- Losses of 85% and over are assessed at 100%.
- All crops covered, standing or in the swath.
- Last day for application is August 1<sup>st</sup>.



#### BEFORE YOUR ROUND

- All tee times MUST be prebooked WALK-ONS will NOT be permitted. Call 306-749-2211 to book (Tee-on on-line booking will be available in the near future https://www.tee-on.com).
- Arrive no more than 15 minutes before your round and arrive on-time as we won't have the
- flexibility to fit you in. Tee times are now booked every 12 minutes (previously 10 minutes) 🕬 If you have any COVID-19 symptoms, if you have been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19, or if you have left the province in the last 14 days STAY HOME

#### FACILITY CHANGES

- The course washroom is closed; clubhouse washrooms are op
- Hand sanitizer is available outside and inside the clubhouse and outside the cart shed.
- Am All carts, keys and cooler bags are sanitized after each use.

- \* A maximum of four players per group is permitted.
  \*Social distancing (2m/6ft) is required AT ALL TIMES, including with all golf course staff.
