


A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN PERTAINING TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND SUBDIVISION OF LAND WITHIN THE TOWN.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town deems it desirable and expedient to pass a Bylaw with respect to the uniform charges for development of new subdivisions within the Town;

AND WHEREAS the development of new lots created a demand on the existing
Water supply and Sewage Lagoon systems,

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- I. Each lot in any new subdivision shall be assessed \$100.00 per front meter as an off-site development cost.
- II. All monies received as per section I, shall be credited to a special reserve account.
- III. Council may withdraw any funds as it deems necessary from the special reserve account by resolution for the purpose of financing part of the costs for capital construction costs to Water and/or Sewage Utility expansion.
- IV. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of the final passing thereof.
