Bylaw No. 4/84

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING EVACUATION FOR THE BIRCH HILLS AND DISTRICT NURSING HOME INC.

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills, in the Province of Saskatchewan

enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the Town of Birch Hills, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified as Exhibit "A" with the following corporation:

Birch Hills and District Nursing Home Inc.
for the purpose stated within the Agreement.

2. The Mayor and Town Administrator of the Town of Birch Hills are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit "A".

EVACUATION AGREEMENT - DISASTER SITUATIONS

In the event of any major disaster (fire, loss of utilities services, flood, earthquake, chemical or other contamination, etc.), where it becomes necessary to partially or fully evacuate the residents of Birch Hills And District Nursing Home Inc., otherwise known as Birchview Home, it is hereby agreed that The TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS will provide temporary accomodation in the Birch Hills Civic Centre and the use of the Kitchen and Washroom facilities in that building.

It is understood that this would be a temporary measure and would be in effect until such time that one of the following would take place:

- a) That the Facility known as Birchview Home would be cleared for habitation and services for the residents, and all further threat of the disaster would be non-existent.
- b) That all of the residents would be discharged into the care of their families or billeted out in the community or transferred into other special care homes in the event of a long term evacuation.

It is also understood that the residents of Birchview Home would receive priority for accomodation at the Birch Hills Civic Centre in the event of a Community wide disaster unless otherwise directed by the E.M.O. Co-ordinator or Mayor of Birch Hills. Should only Birchview Home be involved in the disaster, the accomodation of Residents at The Birch Hills Civic Centre will take precedence over any other functions booked at the Civic Centre.

The provision of food, supplies, blankets, clothing, staffing, and medical items will be the responsibility of Birchview Home to Administer.

This Agreement will be continuous and cancellation of the Agreement may be made by either The Town of Birch Hills or Birchview Home by giving sixty days advance written notice to the other party in the Agreement.
